

## Introduction to English Paper Piecing

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### Workshop Description:

English paper piecing uses a paper shape for each piece in the quilt. This is hand sewing technique that is easy to learn and requires very few supplies. Participants will learn to baste the paper to fabric and how to sew fabric pieces together. Variations in techniques will be discussed so that you can decide what works best for you. There is not a specific class project, but Mary will show and discuss examples of what you can do with paper piecing.



In class you will work towards making one “flower” →



### Class Supply List:

- \_\_\_ Small amounts of assorted fabrics for making flower. Two fat quarters or fat eights should be plenty
- \_\_\_ Thread to match your fabrics and contrasting thread for basting (if desired)
- \_\_\_ Scissors for cutting fabric and paper. I use the same scissors for both.
- \_\_\_ Hand sewing needles and some straight pins
- \_\_\_ Anything else you use for hand sewing, such as thimble and pincushion
