

Mary will show you an easy way to make these great star blocks. Some background fabric and some strings of fabric sew up quickly into Super Stars. No worries about points.

In class you will make one star block and borders, suitable for a wall hanging. Mary will provide you with tips to easily construct these stars and how to make them into a quilt.



Fabric

Background fabric for blocks and borders

- 3/4 yard
- Cut (25) 5 ½ inch squares before class if possible.

<u>Contrasting fabric</u> for star points and border points

- Six or more pieces of fabric that are at least 1/8 yard
- We will be cutting strings/strips in class. Do not cut before class; but feel free to bring fabric strings if you have them.

Backing and binding fabric (will not be used in class)

• 1 yard

Batting (will not be used in class)

A piece that is at least 27" X 27"

Usual sewing supplies

_ Sewing machine (only a straight stitch is required for this technique) and usual machine
sewing supplies, including thread, needles, a seam ripper, and so forth.
_ Cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter, scissors for cutting fabric and batting.

____ Best Press or starch highly recommended.
